Catterick, David, is Assistant Professor of Applied Linguistics at Briercrest College & Seminary. David is the program coordinator for the TESOL program, training students to minister through English language teaching all over the world.

Chugg, Paul, has been a missionary with TEAM since 1993 in Pakistan. His church planting duties have included teaching English as a second language, discipleship, evangelism, and leadership. Currently he is representing TEAM in Western Canada.

Grant, Marion Jean, is a Mobilizer with BCM International (Canada) Inc., conducting seminars and children's mission events.
