In his Assemblies and Seminars he invited us to “Release our hold on the things of this world and allow God to use us for His purposes.” When Bruce Olson was 19, he bought a one-way ticket to South America and traveled into the uncharted jungles of northeast Colombia. There, 58 years ago, he found the Motilonas, a fierce, primitive Indian tribe. Though Olson had no official sponsorship from a missions board or organization, in the ensuing years, he established medical clinics and schools for the tribe. He has translated Scripture into their language, and he has led many of them in accepting Christ as their Savior. In 2009 Bruce Olsson shared his story; this is a riveting session as he tells of his experiences in reaching the Motilonas. <i>Join us at Missions Cinema as we watch “Living in the Jungles of Colombia”</i>
