## 2023 KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



RUSSELL STENDAL

At age four, while his family was living in Minneapolis, MN, Russell prayed and asked God to call his parents, Chad and Pat, to be missionaries. God answered that prayer and within just a few years the whole family was on the mission field in Colombia, South America. He became an accomplished jungle pilot and married a beautiful Colombian lady named Marina. They have four children, Lisa, Alethia, Russell Jr., and Dylan, and six grandchildren.

When he was 27 years old, Marxist guerrillas of the FARC kidnapped him for 142 days. The story of his kidnapping is told in his book Rescue the Captors. His reason for the title is because he realized that his captors were more captive than he was. There was a possibility he would be released, but most of his kidnappers were young people who had been taken from their families, given a weapon, and taught to kill. They had little hope of survival.

To reach all the actors of the armed conflict, including his former captors, Russell established a radio ministry to air programs into the dangerous war stricken areas of Colombia with messages of peace and hope. He has written more than 50 books in English and Spanish; he is the editor of the Jubilee Bible translation in both languages. Well over a million

copies have been donated and distributed into the most needy areas of Colombia and Venezuela.

Russell travels extensively as a speaker around the world. His speaking is unique, he is very sensitive to the Lord's voice and does not hesitate to deliver the message imparted to him, no matter how uncomfortable that may be to him or to others.



SHOAIB EBADI

Shoaib Ebadi is the President and Executive Director of Square One World Media.

He was born and raised in Kabul, Afghanistan. Shoaib was raised in a devout Muslim family. In 1999, when Shoaib was living in Pakistan, a missionary couple from North Carolina offered to teach him English, using the Bible as a textbook. Shoaib had no interest in Christianity, but was willing to read the Bible as a way to learn English. He believed it would be harmless. But along with the language, Shoaib learned the saving power of the Gospel. He accepted the invitation of Matthew 11:28 and became a follower of Jesus Christ.

Shoaib immigrated to Canada in 2000. He was instrumental in establishing the CHAI Immigrant Centre (Christians Helping All Immigrants) in 2007 to help refugees and other newcomers settle in Winnipeg.

He beame a missionary with Pamir Productions, a division of Operation Mobilization that shares the Gospel with Afghans through media and discipleship, in 2009. Hosts a weekly live evangelical telecast that airs in Afghanistan, Iran and the

Middle East. Has been part of the effort to produce a Dari translation of the Bible.

In recent years: has spoken in many churches, partnered with "Voice of the Martyrs, USA" to work with persecuted Afghan Christians; hosted a live evangelical telecast for Afghan refugees living in Germany and Europe; was a keynote speaker at Missions Fest Alberta in 2018 and Missionfest Manitoba in 2022.

He has been involved with church planting and has served his denomination in the Mission Canada division. For seven years he was the National Director for the Canadian Bible Society and now serves as President/CEO of OneBook. Ted is married to Sue and has two sons.
